

## HONG KONG ARBITRATION MASTERCLASS SERIES 2018 THE FULL PICTURE UNDER ARBITRATION ORDINANCE (CAP. 609)

With the growth of international arbitration and with the recent updated Arbitration Ordinance (Cap.609) of the laws of Hong Kong, things are looking bright for Hong Kong arbitration. The Masterclass Series held in 2016 was fully subscribed, and the organisers believe that time is now right to re-run the Series. The 2018 Series will focus on some of the key principles enshrined within the updated law as well as providing the audience with some recent case precedents to highlight the scope and operations of the law. The Series is suitable for lawyers and non-lawyers alike as the presenter will provide a step by step overview of how an arbitration is conducted within the Hong Kong context.

Dr. Christopher To is an independent mediator and arbitrator who is on the panels of various leading global alternative dispute resolution bodies.
